**+ SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK +**

The words of the Gospel today are clear and to the point: be forgiving, be faithful, and be honest! The work of Jesus was not to replace the Law of God given to their ancestors, but to build upon it and to foster right relationships based upon it. Only when our relationship with God is right can we be right with one another. Anything less will bring condemnation down upon us. Sirach shares with us anew the wisdom of old that our choices are free, but bring consequences for good or for bad. May we choose today to follow Christ, and choose the righteous path in our relationships with one another as brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus.
