+ SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK +
The Baptism of Jesus by John is one of the scenes in Scripture that can be difficult to understand. John's was a baptism of repentance, and yet Jesus was without sin. Jesus' baptism is twofold; he inaugurates the beginning of his public ministry and picks up where John leaves off. John preached of the Kingdom being near; Jesus announces the Kingdom HERE!
