+ SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK +
 The gospel today reminds us that everyone has a place. Of all the biblical passages Jesus could have chosen to read, he read the one from Isaiah. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor.... The very life and mission of Jesus was focused on encountering suffering and being with those who suffer, patiently enduring the pain, holding fast to one's and allowing God's transformational wonders to bring hope and healing. By our baptism we have "put on Christ" and are called to that same life and mission. The human condition, with all of its messiness, irregularities, sinfulness, imperfection, brokenness, suffering, and conflicting ideologies, is our condition. It is also the condition into which God was born. There is room for everyone. The establishment of Isaiah's vision and desire begins when we focus on basic teachings to which Jesus calls us: love God with all your heart, mind, and soul... love your enemies... do good to those who hurt you... do not judge. We can all ask ourselves if my life is unifying the Body of Christ, attending to the needs of all parts and members, and advancing the Kingdom of God. It's not about controlling and defending but healing and empowering. If we take this task to heart and are successful, it can then be said that "today's Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing."
