7. Easter baptisms and other celebrations in church are postponed until further notice from the State and the Diocese. **FUNERALS** may be celebrated at the graveside only with a memorial mass to be scheduled later. There are no opportunities for a repast or luncheon to be held at the Church or the Center.
8. First Holy Communion set for May 3 will be rescheduled at a time that will work for families. Confirmation is now also postponed until a new date can be set with Bishop Roger or delegation given for the pastor to celebrate the sacrament.
9. Please consider mailing in your tithes or using the electronic giving opportunities through Vanco and Cash App. Your faithfulness is most appreciated. At the same time, take care of your business and financial responsibilities at home as needed.



SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK

Alleluia! Christ is risen! Death and the powers of death have no power over our Lord. Sisters and brothers, today we celebrate the fundamental truth that makes us Christians: Christ is not in the tomb, but Christ is resurrected! The tomb is the ultimate reality of death, human death. We all face different tombs in our lives. Our tombs restrict us and confine us. The tombs of our lives limit our faith, hope and love. In a concrete way, we are collectively facing the tomb of the Covid-19 pandemic. Many of us are confined home and our movements are restricted. As I reflect on the meaning of the tomb, it symbolizes total separation and alienation. In our tombs we are separated from our loved ones. In our tombs we are isolated and in despair. There are many things in our lives that could cause us to be alone, separated from our loved ones, and in despair; and the greatest of these things is death. Today as Christians we proclaim that Christ has hallowed our tombs and rolled away the stones that separate us from one another and him. Jesus meets us in the fear of our tombs and gives us the Spirit that gives us the resurrected life. Let us then believe that our tombs and pains do not have the final say. Christ our life has the final say and the powers of death have no hold over us. Christ is risen! Alleluia!
