+ SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK +
The visit of the Magi to the Christ Child is remembered in this Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. Epiphany is a Greek word that means revelation. In the encounter with the Magi from the East, the Gospel writers make it clear that Christ comes to all the nations, not just to the people of Israel. The gifts that they bring are symbolic of the life that Jesus will live, marked by his royal dignity(gold), his divinity (frankincense), and the suffering he will endure (myrrh).
