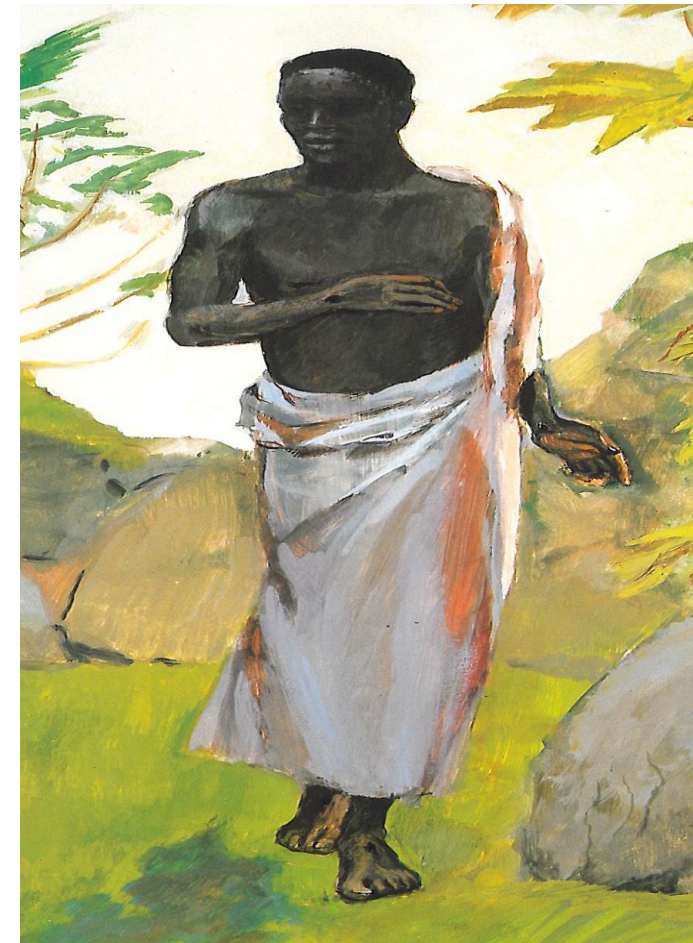

+ **SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK** +

While any attempt to describe the awesomeness of God pales to the fullness who God is, the name of God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is revealed to us in the Scriptures by Jesus himself. Our God is creative, redemptive, and sanctifying in Unity and Trinity. And while this can seem rather heady and theological, we may do well to describe the Trinity using three other words: God is love! It is that bond of love between the Father and the Son that is the Holy Spirit that is expressed in the wonder of Creation at God's hand.
