FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY
BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

+ SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK +
 This feast in honor of the Body and Blood of Christ has its origins in 13th century Belgium at a time when people felt profoundly unworthy to receive the Eucharist. Even with confession, the reluctance of the faithful to eat and drink Holy Communion at Mass led to a "spiritual communion" with Christ through prayer and adoration before the Real Presence of Christ exposed in the monstrance. The Scriptures today make in very clear that the Eucharist is about taking, blessing, breaking, sharing, and eating. In each instance, the communion between God and God's people, and with one another is revealed in these acts of eating and being nourished. In this way, real communion, the Real Presence of Christ is shared not only in prayer and adoration, but in real food to strengthen us for Gospel living. May we eat and drink as Jesus commanded and celebrate the presence of Christ in us, His Mystical Body, the Church.
