TWENTY SIXTH SUNDAY IN
ORDINARY TIME**

For the past weeks, the Gospel of Luke has been warning us about the dangers of an excessive attachment to wealth. Jesus recounts a parable today about a man who had riches, dined bountifully and dressed to impress each day, and a poor man called Lazarus, who was hungry, sick, and had wounds on his body. When both died, there was a reversal of fortunes, the rich man went to the netherworld (sheol, hades, hell) and Lazarus was taken to the bosom of Abraham (eternal bliss, heaven). The rich man's sin was the sin of omission: he did nothing to help Lazarus. His was a sin of inaction. Jesus warns us that at the end of our lives we shall be judged by how well we used our resources, gifts and talents to help others. Let us not be attached to wealth, but use it to help those in need.
