SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK

Today's Gospel story is the famous encounter between Zaccheus and Jesus. Zaccheus has seen Jesus for some time; What is different today is that Jesus sees him! Jesus calls Zaccheus by name and sits with him at supper in his own house. When we recognize that it is God who sees us and loves us as his own then we can come to see ourselves as we truly are as called and loved by God. Others were no doubt jealous of this tax collector, but he proves himself righteous before Jesus and is seen for who he truly is, a man of faith and integrity. May we be concerned this week about how God sees us, and may we too come to know that salvation has come to us!
