The sisters ministry especially to women, children, and the neglected, operating centers for orphaned and disabled children, orphanages, and health clinics in the remote areas of the country. There are over 800 sisters serving in Tanzania, Kenya, Zambia, Rome, and the United States. Sister is already assisting with SWAGG and will be looking to begin medical studies this year.
