Altar Server Duties and Expectations

- 1. All servers are expected to be at the Church 20 minutes before Mass begins. Earlier when deemed necessary.
- 2. All servers are to sign in when they serve, then check with the Priest or Deacon to see what needs to be done to prepare for Mass.
- 3. All servers are expected to fulfill their assigned times to serve.
- 4. All servers are expected to contact the liturgical schedule coordinator or the parish office if they cannot make their assigned Mass.
- 5. All servers are expected to dress appropriately for Mass.
- 6. All servers are expected to hang up their vestments after Mass.
- 7. All servers are expected to participate in the Mass and be attentive to their responsibilities.
- 8. All servers are expected to know and say the appropriate responses throughout the Mass.
- 9. All servers are asked to extinguish the candles after Mass and help bring in the sacred vessels and cruets from the credence table particularly in the absence of a sacristan.
- 10. Adult Servers 18 and older must complete Virtus Substantial Contact with Children training.
