July 30, 2023 Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK

In the First Reading today, the Lord was pleased with Solomon's request that he be granted an understanding heart to govern the People of God. Why? Solomon humbly recognized his limitations and wisely chose to put the governance of the people in the hands of God by relying on divine gifts rather than on his own human wisdom or worldly powers. His choice of words revealed that he recognized the people belonged to God. "I serve you in the midst of the people whom you have chosen, a people so vast that it cannot be numbered or counted. For who is able to govern this vast *people of yours?*"(1 Kings 3:7-9). Solomon's words to the Lord's revealed a heart that loved God above all things preferring God be glorified and that the Lord be their true King. He also loved the people because he wanted what was truly good for them, which was to give them to the Providence of God. Paul writes about the benefits of such love as he states, "We know that all things work for good for those who love God..."(Romans 8:28) Seeking His glory and that His kingdom will reign is the priority of those who love him. Jesus teaches us in the Lord's prayer that this should be the desire of those who love the Father: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be you name. Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. May we always desire to put the Kingdom of the Lord above all things and that He be the ruler of our lives and the world.


