SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK

In today's Gospel, Peter, James and John are revealed as Jesus special inner circle. They are granted a special privilege of receiving a glimpse of his divinity and glory. This experience would be critical in helping them to have faith in Jesus as the promised Messiah revealed in the prophet Daniel's vision, and prophesized by Moses, Elijah. This experience would also be critical in filling them with the fortitude to "..listen to Him." Jesus knew that they would need His help as they prepare to deal with His coming Passion and to help them persevere as His Apostles. The Father voice proclaiming that Jesus is his Beloved Son of God comes also with the proclamation that in Jesus, the Father is **well pleased**. Therefore, if the Father is well pleased with Jesus, those who listen to the Son and live as He lived please the Father also. Peter affirms this when he reflects on that experience stating, "We ourselves heard this voice come from heaven while we were with him on the holy mountain. Moreover, we possess the prophetic message that is altogether reliable." We should not waste time paralyzed by fear to follow Jesus. We can rely on those words from heaven that to live as Jesus commands us to do is pleasing to the Father. Therefore, let us get up out of our comfort zones and our attitudes, listen to Christ, and do as he commands in faith, hope and love. Through the Sacraments beginning with baptism, Jesus has called us into His inner circle and invites us to know Him more intimately. More so, He wants us to have no fear to listen to him by going forth putting into practice what He teaches. In doing so, we will truly please the Father.


