October 22, 2023 Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION THIS WEEK

What "Belongs to God?": The Pharisees, were trying to trap Jesus into destroying Himself with this question about paying taxes. Our Lord recognized knowing their hearts despite their flattering words, loved them and did not seek to humiliate them with his response. He exhorted them to give to God what belongs to God. The Gospel tells us that "When they heard this they were amazed." The Lord calls us to reflect on that question for ourselves. "What belongs to God?" The answer is that ALL THINGS IN HEAVEN AND EARTH BELONG TO GOD. Even Caesar belonged to God. In the First Reading, God revealed this to the Persian ruler, King Cyrus, who did the work of God even though he did not know the one true God. As He proclaimed through the prophet Isaiah, "I have called you by your name, giving you a title, though you knew me not. We consider that we too belong to God and all that we have belongs to him. Do we Love God by giving to him our thoughts, words, actions, time, talents, and sufferings. When we give him ourselves and all that we have, he we don't lose out; rather, we become the precious treasure he created us to be. In the words of St. Nicholas of Flüe, we pray: "My Lord and my God, take from me everything that distances me from you. My Lord and my God, give me everything that brings me closer to you. My Lord and my God, detach me from myself to give my all to you"


